LAKE VERA WATERFRONT RULES

SWIMMING:


- 1. NO SWIMMING ALLOWED IF UNDER 18 UNLESS PARENT OR LIFEGUARD IS PRESENT.
- 2. NO DIVING ALLOWED.
- 3. NONSWIMMERS must wear life jackets.
- 4. Check with Lifeguard before changing swim areas.
- 5. Always swim with your buddy.
- 6. Remain in the roped swimming area at all times.
- 7. Never hang or pull on the ropes.
- 8. NO diving from or swimming under the floating raft/dock.
- 9. Never rock the floating raft/dock.
- 10. Call for help only if you really need it.
- 11. NO swimming after 9:00 p.m.
- 12. NO hiking, walking, or playing on the dam.
- 13. NO swimming near the dam.
- 14. All lake swims must be accompanied by a lifeguard.
- 15. Swimmers are to swim in the private swim area of Camp Watanda.
- 16. NO nude swimming or sunbathing.
- 17. Only BIODEGRADABLE shampoos/soaps may be used in the lake.

BOATING:

1. NO BOATING ALLOWED IF UNDER 18 UNLESS PARENT OR LIFEGUARD IS PRESENT

- 2. Only non-motorized boats are permitted, no jet skis.
- 3. Notify lifeguard before taking boats out.
- 4. ALL BOATERS must wear a Personal Flotation Device (Life Jacket).
- 5. Kneel, NEVER stand up in boats, canoes, or kayaks.
- 6. Maximum of 4 persons in each canoe.
- 7. ALWAYS remain 10 boat lengths away from the dam.
- 8. Be aware of submerged lake obstacles as noted on map.
- 9. No boating after 9:00 p.m.
- 10. Rock Creek and Brush Creek are off limits to boaters.
- 11. No boating in any camp swimming area.
- 12. No tipping or charging other canoes.
- 13. DO NOT pick the Water Lilies.

LAKE VERA: There are 3 clusters of submerged rocks as noted on the diagram. The "Turtle Rock" cluster is usually visible towards the end of the summer, but is a boating hazard in early summer as the rocks are just barely below the surface; the other two clusters are located in "Out of Bounds" boating areas. One is located in front of the dam, the other in the camp swim area to the right of the dam. **THERE IS NO DIVING!** This includes from the rafts or boats.



I will instruct my guests and comply with all aspects of the Lake Vera Waterfront rules. A lifeguard, parent or responsible adult will supervise anyone swimming or boating who is under 18. All boaters under 18 will wear a life jacket as provided by Camp Watanda.
